Middle School (Grades 6 - 8):

Continue hybrid schedule; option for fully virtual.

High School (Grades 9 - 12):

Continue hybrid schedule; option for fully virtual.

Reconfirm whether or not the district is offering higher levels of in-person instruction for English language learners, special education students, or other special populations:

Options provided to students as needed.
