<b>Reconfirm how instruction will be delivered for each grade level:</b>
Pre-Kindergarten: Continue fully virtual through November 25, 2020; begin hybrid October 30, 2020; option for fully virtual.
Elementary (Grades K - 5): Continue fully virtual through November 25, 2020; begin hybrid October 30, 2020; option for fully virtual.
Middle School (Grades 6 - 8): Continue fully virtual through November 25, 2020; begin hybrid October 30, 2020; option for fully virtual.
High School (Grades 9 - 12): Continue fully virtual through December 9, 2020; begin hybrid December 10, 2020; option for fully virtual.
